AN ACT Relating to expediting licensure for cosmetologists, hair designers, barbers, manicurists, and estheticians; and amending RCW 3 18.16.090.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 Sec. 1. RCW 18.16.090 and 2003 c 400 s 4 are each amended to 6 read as follows:

7 Examinations for licensure under this chapter shall be conducted at such times and places as the director determines appropriate. 8 9 Examinations shall consist of tests designed to reasonably measure 10 the applicant's knowledge of safe and sanitary practices and may also 11 include the applicant's knowledge of this chapter and rules adopted 12 pursuant to this chapter. The director may establish by rule a performance examination in addition to any other examination. The 13 14 director shall establish by rule the minimum passing score for all examinations and the requirements for reexamination of applicants who 15 16 fail the examination or examinations. The director may allow an 17 independent person to conduct the examinations at the expense of the 18 applicants.

19 The director shall take steps to ensure that after completion of 20 the required course or apprenticeship program, applicants may 21 promptly take the examination and receive the results of the

examination. The director may allow an applicant to register for or take an examination before the applicant has completed the required hours of course instruction, if the applicant is within 100 hours of completion, but the applicant must complete the required hours of course instruction before licensure.
