1 AN ACT Relating to special use permits for milk product haulers; 2 and amending RCW 46.44.0941.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 Sec. 1. RCW 46.44.0941 and 2010 c 161 s 1117 are each amended to 5 read as follows:

6 The following fees, in addition to the regular license and 7 tonnage fees, shall be paid for all movements under special permit 8 made upon state highways. All funds collected, except the amount 9 retained by authorized agents of the department as provided in RCW 10 46.44.096, shall be forwarded to the state treasury and shall be 11 deposited in the motor vehicle fund:

1 Continuous operation of a combination of 2 vehicles having one trailing unit that 3 exceeds ((fifty-three)) 53 feet and is not more than ((fifty-six)) 56 feet in length, for 4 5 6 Continuous operation of a combination of 7 vehicles having two trailing units which together exceed ((sixty-one)) 61 feet and 8 9 are not more than ((sixty-eight)) 68 feet in length, for a period of one year. . . . . . . . . . . \$ 100.00 10 Continuous operation of a combination of 11 12 vehicles having two trailing units 13 hauling fluid/liquid nondivisible milk, 14 which together exceed 61 feet and 15 are not more than 85 feet in length, for 16 <u>a period of one year....\$ 300.00</u> 17 Continuous operation of a three-axle fixed 18 load vehicle having less than 65,000 19 pounds gross weight, for a period not 20 to exceed ((thirty)) <u>30</u> days.... \$ 70.00 21 Continuous operation of a four-axle fixed load 22 vehicle meeting the requirements of 23 RCW 46.44.091(1) and weighing less than 86,000 pounds gross weight, not to exceed 24 25 ((thirty)) <u>30</u> days.... \$ 90.00 Continuous movement of a mobile home or manufactured 26 27 home having nonreducible features not to 28 exceed ((eighty-five)) 85 feet in total length and 29 ((fourteen)) 14 feet in width, for a period of 30 31 Continuous operation of a class C tow truck or a 32 class E tow truck with a class C rating while 33 performing emergency and nonemergency tows of 34 oversize or overweight, or both, vehicles and vehicle combinations, under rules adopted by the 35 36 transportation commission, for a period of 37 Continuous operation of a class B tow truck or a 38 39 class E tow truck with a class B rating while 40 performing emergency and nonemergency tows of

1 oversize or overweight, or both, vehicles and vehicle combinations, under rules adopted by the 2 3 transportation commission, for a period of 4 5 Continuous operation of a two or three-axle 6 collection truck, actually engaged in the 7 collection of solid waste or recyclables, or both, under chapter 81.77 or 35.21 RCW 8 or by contract under RCW 36.58.090, for 9 one year with an additional ((six thousand)) 6,000 10 11 pounds more than the weight authorized in 12 RCW 46.16A.455 on the rear axle of a two-axle truck or ((eight thousand)) 8,000 pounds for the tandem 13 axles of a three-axle truck. RCW 46.44.041 14 and 46.44.091 notwithstanding, the tire limits 15 16 specified in RCW 46.44.042 apply, but none of 17 the excess weight is valid or may be permitted 18 on any part of the federal interstate highway 19 system....\$ 42.00 20 per thousand pounds 21 The department may issue any of the above-listed permits that involve height, length, or width for an expanded period of 22 23 consecutive months, not to exceed one year. 24 Continuous operation of farm implements under a permit issued as 25 authorized by RCW 46.44.140 by: 26 (1) Farmers in the course of farming activities, 27 28 (2) Farmers in the course of farming activities, 29 for a period not to exceed one year. . . . . . . . . . \$ 25.00 (3) Persons engaged in the business of the 30 31 sale, repair, or maintenance of such 32 farm implements, for any three-month period. . . . . . \$ 25.00 (4) Persons engaged in the business of the 33 34 sale, repair, or maintenance of such 35 farm implements, for a period not to 36 37 Overweight Fee Schedule

The fee for weights in excess of 100,000 pounds is \$4.25 plus ((fifty)) 50 cents for each 5,000 pound increment or portion thereof exceeding 100,000 pounds.

26 PROVIDED: (a) The minimum fee for any overweight permit shall be 27 \$14.00, (b) the fee for issuance of a duplicate permit shall be 28 \$14.00, (c) when computing overweight fees prescribed in this section 29 or in RCW 46.44.095 that result in an amount less than even dollars 30 the fee shall be carried to the next full dollar if ((fifty)) 50 31 cents or over and shall be reduced to the next full dollar if 32 ((forty-nine)) 49 cents or under.

The fees levied in this section and RCW 46.44.095 do not apply to vehicles owned and operated by the state of Washington, a county
