AN ACT Relating to the repeal of resentencing provisions for individuals sentenced as a persistent offender due to a robbery in the second degree conviction; amending RCW 9.94A.345; and repealing RCW 9.94A.647.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Sec. 1. RCW 9.94A.647 (Resentencing—Persistent 7 offenders—Robbery in the second degree) and 2021 c 141 s 1 are each 8 repealed.

9 Sec. 2. RCW 9.94A.345 and 2021 c 286 s 2 are each amended to 10 read as follows:

((Except as otherwise provided in this chapter, any)) Any sentence imposed under this chapter shall be determined in accordance with the law in effect when the current offense was committed.
