- 1 AN ACT Relating to health care plans administered by the health

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** (1) The legislature recognizes that the 6 health care authority, consistent with the public employees' benefits
- 7 board resolution 2022-16, will consult with active employees and
- 8 retirees, by conducting listening sessions and facilitating public
- 9 forums, to gather feedback about retiree needs. The legislature
- 10 intends that the results of stakeholder engagements will be used to
- 11 inform future health care plan selections.
- 12 (2) By December 1, 2023, the authority must report to the
- 13 legislature with its findings of the stakeholder engagements in
- 14 subsection (1) of this section and an analysis of government self-
- 15 insured plans with benefits that are equal to or richer, and with
- 16 more affordable premiums, than uniform medical plan classic medicare.

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
