1 AN ACT Relating to human trafficking training for criminal
2 justice personnel; and adding a new section to chapter 43.101 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 43.101
5 RCW to read as follows:

6 (1) The commission shall offer training on human trafficking to
7 criminal justice and correctional personnel, and other public safety
8 employees. The training shall be implemented by the commission in
9 consultation with appropriate public and private organizations that
10 have expertise in reducing and preventing human trafficking.

11 (2) The training shall consist of a minimum of one hour of
12 classroom or internet instruction, and shall include instruction on
13 the following subjects:

14 (a) How to identify suspicious illegal human trafficking
15 activities; and

16 (b) Examples of where a victim of human trafficking may get help
17 for health care, human services, housing, education, legal
18 assistance, job training or preparation, interpreting services,
19 English as a second language classes, and victim's compensation.

1 (3) The training developed by the commission shall be made
2 available by the commission to all employees of state and local
3 agencies that perform public safety duties.

4 (4) The commission shall incorporate all relevant components of
5 the training program required in RCW 43.280.095.
