- AN ACT Relating to responsibility for providing service by 1 2 publication of a summons or notice in dependency and termination of 3 parental rights cases; amending RCW 13.34.080; creating a 4 section; and providing an effective date.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 Sec. 1. RCW 13.34.080 and 2000 c 122 s 9 are each amended to 7 read as follows:
 - (1) The court shall direct the ((elerk)) petitioner to publish notice in a legal newspaper ((printed in the county, qualified to publish summons)), as described under RCW 65.16.020, once a week for three consecutive weeks, with the first publication of the notice to be at least twenty-five days prior to the date fixed for the hearing when it appears by the petition or verified statement that:
 - (a)(i) The parent or quardian is a nonresident of this state; or
- (ii) The name or place of residence or whereabouts of the parent 16 or quardian is unknown; and
 - (b) After due diligence, the person attempting service of the summons or notice provided for in RCW 13.34.070 has been unable to make service, and a copy of the notice has been deposited in the post office, postage prepaid, directed to such person at his or her last known place of residence. If the parent, guardian, or legal custodian

is believed to be a resident of another state or a county other than the county in which the petition has been filed, notice also shall be published in the county in which the parent, guardian, or legal custodian is believed to reside.

- (2) Publication may proceed simultaneously with efforts to 5 provide service in person or by mail, when the court determines there 6 7 is reason to believe that service in person or by mail will not be successful. Notice shall be directed to the parent, parents, or other 8 9 person claiming the right to the custody of the child, if their names are known. If their names are unknown, the phrase "To whom it may 10 concern" shall be used, apply to, and be binding upon, those persons 11 whose names are unknown. The name of the court, the name of the child 12 13 (or children if of one family), the date of the filing of the petition, the date of hearing, and the object of the proceeding in 14 general terms shall be set forth. There shall be filed with the clerk 15 an affidavit showing due publication of the notice. ((The)) 16
- 17 (3) (a) Except as provided in (b) of this subsection, the cost of publication shall be paid by the ((county)) petitioner at a rate not 18 greater than the rate paid for other legal notices. 19
- (b) If the petitioner is a minor child or the court finds that 21 the petitioner is an indigent parent or legal guardian, the cost of publication shall be paid or reimbursed by the office of civil legal 22 aid where the petitioner is a minor child, or the office of public 23 24 defense where the petitioner is a parent or legal quardian, pursuant 25 to procedures set by each agency.
- 26 (4) The publication of notice shall be deemed equivalent to 27 personal service upon all persons, known or unknown, who have been 28 designated as provided in this section.
- Sec. 2. If specific funding for the purposes of 29 NEW SECTION. this act, referencing this act by bill or chapter number, is not 30 provided by June 30, 2024, in the omnibus appropriations act, this 31 act is null and void. 32
- 33 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** This act takes effect January 31, 2026.
