

RCW 48.22.100 Automobile insurance policies—Personal injury protection coverage—Request by named insured—Benefit limits. If requested by a named insured, an insurer providing automobile liability insurance policies must offer personal injury protection coverage for each insured with benefit limits as follows:

- (1) Medical and hospital benefits of thirty-five thousand dollars;
- (2) A funeral expense benefit of two thousand dollars;
- (3) Income continuation benefits of thirty-five thousand dollars, subject to a limit of seven hundred dollars per week; and
- (4) Loss of services benefits of fourteen thousand six hundred dollars. [2003 c 115 § 5; 1993 c 242 § 5.]
