

RCW 19.182.130 Obtaining information under false pretenses—

Penalty. A person who knowingly and willfully obtains information on a consumer from a consumer reporting agency under false pretenses is subject to a fine of up to five thousand dollars or imprisonment for up to three hundred sixty-four days, or both. [2011 c 96 § 21; 1993 c 476 § 15.]
