- RCW 28B.10.708 Graduation ceremonies—Tribal regalia. (1) Institutions of higher education may not prohibit students who are members of a federally recognized tribe from wearing traditional tribal regalia or objects of Native American cultural significance along with or attached to a gown at graduation ceremonies or related events. Institutions of higher education may not require such students to wear a cap if it is incompatible with the regalia or significant object.
- (2) Institutions of higher education shall update any relevant policies or procedures in accordance with this section.
- (3) For the purposes of this section, "institutions of higher education" has the same meaning as in RCW 28B.10.016. [2020 c 35 § 4.]
