- RCW 74.08A.120 Immigrants and victims of human trafficking—Food assistance. (1) The department may establish a food assistance program for legal immigrants and victims of human trafficking as defined in RCW 74.04.005 who are ineligible for the federal food stamp program.
- (2) The rules for the state food assistance program shall follow exactly the rules of the federal food stamp program except for the provisions pertaining to immigrant status.
- (3) The benefit under the state food assistance program shall be established by the legislature in the biennial operating budget.
- (4) The department may enter into a contract with the United States department of agriculture to use the existing federal food stamp program coupon system for the purposes of administering the state food assistance program.
- (5) In the event the department is unable to enter into a contract with the United States department of agriculture, the department may issue vouchers to eligible households for the purchase of eligible foods at participating retailers. [2020 c 136 \S 2; 1999 c 120 \S 4; 1997 c 57 \S 3.]
