- WAC 110-300-0230 First-aid supplies. (1) An early learning provider must keep a complete first-aid kit in the licensed space, on any off-site trip, and in a vehicle used to transport children in care. A first-aid kit must:
 - (a) Be stored in a location that is easily accessible to staff;
 - (b) Be inaccessible to children;
 - (c) Be separate from food or chemicals;
 - (d) Be kept clean and sanitary;
 - (e) Be stored in a manner that prevents contamination; and
- (f) Have sufficient supplies for the number of enrolled children and staff consistent with the early learning program's licensed capacity, or sufficient supplies for each room in the licensed space.
 - (2) A first-aid kit must include:
 - (a) Disposable nonporous protective nonlatex gloves;
 - (b) Adhesive bandages of various sizes;
 - (c) Small scissors;
 - (d) Tweezers;
 - (e) An elastic wrapping bandage;
 - (f) Sterile gauze pads;
 - (g) Ice packs;
- (h) A disposable or mercury free thermometer that uses disposable sleeves, or is cleaned and sanitized after each use;
 - (i) A sling, or a large triangular bandage;
 - (j) Adhesive tape;
- (k) A CPR barrier with a one-way valve or both an adult and pediatric CPR mask with a one-way valve;
 - (1) A current first-aid manual; and
 - (m) Hand sanitizer (for adult use only).
