

WAC 246-215-08120 Variances—Conformance with approved procedures (FDA Food Code 8-103.12). If the REGULATORY AUTHORITY grants a VARIANCE as specified under WAC 246-215-08110, or a HACCP PLAN is otherwise required as specified under WAC 246-215-08210, the PERMIT HOLDER shall:

- (1) Maintain the APPROVED VARIANCE at the FOOD ESTABLISHMENT; and
- (2) Comply with the HACCP PLANS and procedures that are submitted as specified under WAC 246-215-08215 and APPROVED as a basis for the modification or waiver; and
- (3) Maintain and provide to the REGULATORY AUTHORITY, upon request, records specified under WAC 246-215-08215 (4) and (5) that demonstrate that the following are routinely employed:
 - (a) Procedures for monitoring CRITICAL CONTROL POINTS;
 - (b) Monitoring of the CRITICAL CONTROL POINTS;
 - (c) Verification of the effectiveness of the operation or process; and
 - (d) Necessary corrective actions if there is a failure at a CRITICAL CONTROL POINT.
