**WAC 296-874-20058 Make sure personal fall arrest systems meet these requirements.** (1) You must make sure personal fall arrest systems used on scaffolds for general industry activities, meet the requirements of personal fall arrest system, Appendix C, Part 1, WAC 296-24-88050, in powered platforms, Part J-3, found in the general safety and health standards, chapter 296-24 WAC.

(2) You must make sure personal fall arrest systems are attached by a lanyard to one of the following:

- (a) Vertical lifeline;
- (b) Horizontal lifeline;
- (c) Appropriate structural member of the scaffold.
