

**WAC 357-58-265 When may an agency make an acting WMS appointment and what actions are required?** (1) An agency may make nonpermanent appointments in WMS which are called acting appointments. Acting WMS appointments can be made when any of the following conditions exist:

(a) When necessary to meet organization needs; or

(b) When approval has been granted by the director to redeploy an employee in accordance with WAC 357-04-124.

(2) Prior to the acting appointment, the appointing authority must communicate in writing to the employee the anticipated length, intent, salary, and other conditions of the appointment.
