You must ensure you are in compliance with all federal and state laws, regulations and programs that apply to lending or brokering loans, servicing residential mortgage loans, including applicable reverse mortgage, or servicing student education loans including, but not limited to, the Truth in Lending Act, the Equal Credit Opportunity Act, the Home Mortgage Disclosure Act, the Bank Secrecy Act, the Real Estate Settlement Procedures Act, the Gramm-Leach-Bliley Act, the Fair Debt Collection Practices Act, the Fair Credit Reporting Act, the Federal Trade Commission Act, the Telemarketing and Consumer Fraud and Abuse Act, the Washington State Fair Housing Act, the S.A.F.E. Act, the Federal Trade Commission Telemarketing Sales Rule, and the Mortgage Acts and Practices - Advertising statute, Regulation N, 12 C.F.R. Part 1014.
