ORDER ADOPTING REGULATION

WHEREAS, RCW 14.04.270 provides that the Washington State Aeronautics Commission may by rule and regulation establish conditions for the safe use of airports licensed by said commission, and

WHEREAS, RCW 14.04.270 provides that the Washington State Aeronautics Commission may make reasonable classifications of airport in enacting its regulations, and

WHEREAS, RCW 14.04.100 provides that the Washington State Aeronautics Commission is authorized to regulate airports within the State of Washington, and

WHEREAS, RCW 14.04.210 provides that the Washington State Aeronautics Commission may adopt regulations and amend regulations establishing minimum standards for matters within the jurisdiction of the said commission, and

WHEREAS, the Regulation No. 3, adopted by the Washington State Aeronautics Commission on July 14, 1961, is inadequate and outmoded in its classification of airports, and

WHEREAS, the 1962 edition of Suggestions for Aircraft Rescue and Fire Fighting Services for Airports and Heliports, published by the National Fire Protection Association, Boston, Massachusetts (NFPA #403), is a nationally recognized standard for the prevention and control of fires and fire hazards of airports and heliports, and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned booklet, NFPA #403, is applicable to the State of Washington, and

WHEREAS, fire prevention controls and adequate fire fighting equipment at airports and heliports is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare, and

STATE OF WASHINGTON
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WHEREAS, the Washington State Aeronautics Commission adopted the aforementioned booklet, NFPA #403 as an emergency regulation on September 1, 1965,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, that pursuant to RCW 14.04.100, 14.04.210 and 14.04.270, the 1962 edition of Suggestions for Aircraft Rescue and Fire Fighting Services at Airports and Heliports, published by the National Fire Protection Association, Boston, Massachusetts (NFPA #403), attached hereto and made a part hereof be, and the same is hereby adopted as Regulation No. 3 of the Washington State Aeronautics Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that this regulation shall supersede Regulation No. 3, adopted on the 1st day of September, 1965 as an emergency regulation, and any other regulation of the Washington State Aeronautics Commission that is in conflict herewith.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that this regulation shall be effective 12:01 a.m. December 1, 1965.
