REGULATIONS GOVERNING THE TRANSPORTATION AND DISPOSAL  
OF DEAD ANIMALS, PACKING HOUSE OFFAL AND MEAT MARKET SCRAPS

I, Sverre N. Omdahl, Director of Agriculture of the State of Washington, by virtue of authority vested in me under Section 17, Chapter 100, Session Laws of 1949, do make and issue the following regulations providing for the transportation and disposal of dead animals, packing house offal and meat market scraps in the State of Washington:

Regulation 1. All vehicles used in transporting whole dead animal carcasses or parts of dead animal carcasses shall be covered with a suitable tarpaulin or other covering in such a way that the contents shall not be openly exposed to insects.

Regulation 2. All vehicles used in transporting packing house offal or meat market scraps in barrels or other containers shall have permanently covered truck beds with a rear canvas drop; provided that suitable, tight fitting, metal covers for barrels or other containers may be used in uncovered vehicles.

Regulation 3. No carcass of a dead meat food animal, parts of carcasses of a dead meat food animal, packing house offal, or meat market scraps shall be transferred by an independent collector other than to a licensed rendering plant.

Regulation 4. No carcass of a dead meat food animal, parts of carcasses of a dead meat food animal, packing house offal, or meat market scraps shall be transferred by a licensed rendering plant to any other person or establishment except for processing at a licensed rendering plant.
