EMERGENCY ORDER NO. 379

EFFECTIVE DECEMBER 8, 1961

Declaring Starlings to be injurious to agriculture

The adoption to this emergency order declaring the starling to be a bird injurious to agriculture is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare. It is necessary that this order become effective immediately in order that the Department undertake programs for starling control.

Now, therefore, I, Joe Dwyer, Director of the Department of Agriculture of the State of Washington, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Chapter 247, Laws of 1961, and 34.04 RCW, do hereby promulgate the following emergency regulation.

Regulation 1. The Starling is hereby declared to be a bird injurious to agriculture in the State of Washington.
