
WAC 16-212-00101 PROMULGATION. (This promulgation relates to Order No. 1267 and WAC 16-212-110 and 130).

I, Stewart Bledsoe, director of agriculture of the state of Washington, by virtue of the authority vested in me under chapter 22.09 RCW, after due notice as provided under chapters 42.32 and 34.04 RCW, and a public hearing held in Spokane, Washington on May 31, 1974, do hereby promulgate the following regulations relating to warehouse bonding requirements and warehouseman net worth requirements.

AMD WAC 16-212-110 WAREHOUSE BONDING REQUIREMENTS. A bond of not less than \$10,000 nor more than \$200,000, is required for each warehouseman licensed pursuant to chapter 22.09 RCW, Laws of 1963, the Washington Warehouse Act. The amount of such bond shall be computed at the rate of \$0.18 per bushel of licensed storage capacity.

AMD WAC 16-212-130 WAREHOUSEMAN NET WORTH REQUIREMENTS. An allowable net worth of \$0.15 per bushel of licensed space, with a minimum of \$10,000 is required for each warehouseman licensed pursuant to chapter 22.09 RCW, Laws of 1963, the Washington Warehouse Act. Any deficiency above the \$10,000 minimum must be compensated for by increasing the amount of the warehouse bond by the amount of the deficiency, regardless of the \$200,000 maximum as set forth in WAC 16-212-110.
