Dear Sir:

There are enclosed herewith two regulations, one copy each, promulgated by the Washington State Dairy Products Commission at its meeting on June 15, 1973. The meeting was held at the Olympic Hotel in Seattle, Washington at 9:00 AM pursuant to notice in accordance with the Administrative Procedures Act.

The meeting was called for the purpose of considering a permanent regulation and an emergency or temporary regulation to govern the level of assessments imposed upon the milk produced in the State of Washington and introduced into the channels of trade.

The regulations were adopted formally. We filed copies of the regulations, both the permanent rule which is Order 1-73 and the temporary or emergency rule which is Order 2-73 with the Code Reviser on June 15, 1973. The emergency rule becomes effective July 16, 1973, and the permanent rule becomes effective on August 1, 1973.

Each rule sets the level of the assessment at six tenths of one per cent of the Class I price for 3.5 butterfat milk as determined under the provisions of the Federal Order regulating the marketing of milk in the Puget Sound Washington area. It also prescribes forms for reporting milk production to the Commission.

The regulations were published on or about June 21, 1973 as required by RCW 15.44.070 in newspapers east of the Cascades (Spokane Spokesman Review Chronicle) and west of the Cascades (Seattle Times).
