AMENDATORY SECTION (Amending WSR 92-19-05, filed 9/10/92)

WAC 132H-121-010 Smoking.

It shall be the policy of Bellevue Community College, consistent with its efforts to promote wellness, fitness, and a campus environment conducive to work, study, and activities for staff, students, and the public, to maintain a smoke/tobacco free indoor campus environment.

Smoking and tobacco use is permitted only in designated locations. — ~~Use of tobacco products is permitted on campus outside of the buildings; smoking in covered walkways surrounding main and upper campuses shall be restricted to designated smoking areas.~~ Receptacles for smoking materials are provided and are required to be used to maintain litter free campus grounds.

~~The college recognizes the rights of those who choose to use tobacco and as such does not prohibit the use of tobacco products; it does, however, restrict the use of these materials to areas outside college facilities and vehicles.~~ Information regarding the Bellevue Community College smoking policy is available in Campus Operations, located in K100.
