Dear Mr. White:

Please attach this finding of fact to Community College District #8 Resolution No. 21, Emergency Administrative Order No. 1, which was filed with your office July 13, 1972.

WAC 132H-116-010, which prohibits dumping any materials on the campus, is required to protect the landscaping and ground cover on the campus as well as for sanitary and appearance reasons.

WAC 132H-116-020, which prohibits off-road motor vehicle traffic, is required to prevent damage to landscaping and ground cover resulting from motor vehicles, particularly motorbikes, driving off the paved roads of the campus.

WAC 132H-116-030, which prohibits horseback riding on the campus, is necessary to protect the landscaping and ground cover since there are no bridle trails on the campus.

WAC 132H-116-040, which prohibits operating a motor vehicle without a valid operator's license, is required to control the use of minibikes on the campus.

All four of the above rules were adopted as emergency rules in order to protect newly planted grass on the athletic field of the college.

A RESOLUTION Relating to emergency rules of Community College District #8.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT #8,  
STATE OF WASHINGTON:

Section 1. The annexed regulations, to-wit:

WAC 132H-116-010 PROHIBITION OF DUMPING. No person shall dump any materials on the campus.

WAC 132H-116-020 OFF-ROAD MOTOR VEHICLE TRAFFIC. No person shall drive any motor vehicle off paved roads on the campus.

WAC 132H-116-030 HORSEBACK RIDING. No person shall ride horseback on the campus.

WAC 132H-116-040 DRIVING WITHOUT LICENSE. No person shall operate a motorized vehicle on the campus without a valid operator's license.

are hereby approved and adopted as emergency rules of Community College District #8 to protect newly planted ground cover.


