



WAC 132H-104-130 DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY FOR HIGHER EDUCATION PERSONNEL LAW - CLASSIFIED PERSONNEL. Be it resolved that the President or his designee, the Executive Assistant to the President and Director of Personnel, is hereby designated as the appointing authority of the college for the purpose of the Higher Education Personnel Law. This delegation, if authorized, shall include but not be limited to the authority to employ, dismiss, suspend, demote, lay off or reassign members of the classified staff. In addition, the President or his designee, the Executive Assistant to the President and Director of Personnel, is hereby delegated such authority as is necessary to effectuate the administration of the classified personnel policy. Provided that all contracts between recognized bargaining agents of classified personnel and Bellevue Community College shall be valid only after those contracts have received the approval of the Board of Trustees. The President of the college or his designee, the Executive Assistant to the President and Director of Personnel, may be delegated the authority to negotiate on behalf of the Board of Trustees, but in no event shall the President or his designee, the Executive Assistant to the President and Director of Personnel, be authorized to bind contractually the college in any agreement with a recognized bargaining agent of the classified staff.
