This revision of the University Bookstore used book purchases policy is being proposed so that the policy will be consistent with our general operating procedures. This change should be in effect when our Bookstore textbook buy back takes place at the end of winter quarter, 1983, so that students may receive the most equitable price for used textbooks.

These rules are therefore adopted as emergency rules to take effect upon filing with the code reviser.

## RULE PURPOSE STATEMENT

TITLE: Chapter 106-140 USE OF COLLEGE FACILITIES--BUSINESS OFFICE

STATUTORY AUTHORITY: RCW 28B.35.120(11)

SUMMARY: This proposal will rescind rules regarding used book purchases. The current rule restricts the price paid by the University Store for used textbooks to no more than fifty percent of list price. The decision to purchase used books at the University Store is based upon the market conditions and the needs of the University Store rather than on a fixed policy. There are times when the University Store needs larger quantities of some textbooks and, therefore, needs to pay more than 50%. This is a procedural matter, not one of policy.
