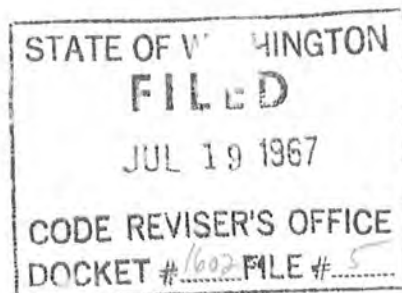

1 NOTICE TO THE CODE REVISER OF THE AMENDMENT OF RULES RELATING TO
2 CHIROPRACTIC BOARD OF EXAMINERS, CHAPTER 114-12.

3 WAC 114-12-080 -----REQUIREMENTS FOR APPROVAL. To be elig-
4 ible for approval, a symposium shall:

5 (1) Be sponsored by an approved chiropractic school or a recog-
6 nized chiropractic organization which is representative of the chiro-
7 practors of a state, a territory, a province, or a country;

8 (2) Extend over a period of at least 2 days, and offer an edu-
9 cation program consisting of at least 8 hours;

10 (3) Include instruction by at least 2 outstanding chiropractic
11 educators; and

12 (4) Devote itself to lectures or demonstrations concerning
13 matters which are recognized in the state of Washington chiropractic
14 licensing laws. (~~;-and~~)
