ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 13

The Washington State Board of Chiropractic Examiners gave notice to the Code Reviser (No. 2217), to the press and other interested persons in accordance with RCW 34.04.025 and 42.32.010 on December 18, 1968, that a hearing would be held on Wednesday, January 8, 1969, at 2:00 p.m. in the Conference Room of the Professional Licensing Division office, Second Floor, Capital Center Building, Olympia, Washington, to consider the adoption of rules requiring applicants for licensure as chiropractors by reciprocity to have a personal interview with the board and successfully demonstrate their ability in practical adjustive technique, and also requiring that the chiropractic examination include X-Ray procedure and interpretation.

On January 8, 1969, the State Board of Chiropractic Examiners held a hearing in the Conference Room of the Professional Licensing Division office in the Capital Center Building, Olympia, Washington, and at that time the board, after considering all pertinent material and comments made by persons in attendance, exercised its judgment by adopting the attached as permanent rules in accordance with the authority conferred by RCW 18.25.017. The board further directed that after the recording of the order in the registry of the agency the rules be forwarded to the Code Reviser for filing pursuant to chapter 34.04 RCW and chapter 1-12 WAC.

Chapter 114-12

BOARD OF CHIROPRACTIC EXAMINERS
RULES

NEW

WAC 114-12-100 LICENSING BY RECIPROCITY. Applicants for licensure by reciprocity must have a personal interview with the board or designated member thereof and must successfully demonstrate his ability in practical adjustive technique prior to being licensed.

NEW

WAC 114-12-110 CHIROPRACTIC EXAMINATION. Chiropractic examinations shall include X-ray procedure and interpretation as part of the chiropractic technique portion of the examination.
