ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 10

(1) I, Richard O. White, Code Reviser of the state of Washington, by virtue of the authority vested in me under chapter 34.04 RCW and RCW 43.21C.120 do promulgate and adopt the annexed rule as an emergency rule of this agency.

(2) The emergency adoption of this rule is necessary in order to comply with the State Environmental Policy Act, which directed adoption of such rule by May 15, 1976; consequently, the adoption of these rules is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, or general welfare and observance of the requirements of notice and opportunity to present views on the proposed action would be contrary to the public interest.
