A resolution relating to permanent rules of the State Board for Community College Education.

WAC 131-28-010 TUITION AND INCIDENTAL FEES FOR SUMMER QUARTERS. The board of trustees of each community college district shall charge to and collect from each student registered full time therein for the summer quarter general tuition and incidental fees as follows:

- (1) Resident students:
 - (a) general tuition fees, fifty dollars per quarter; and
 - (b) incidental fees not more than twenty dollars per quarter.
- (2) Nonresident students:
 - (a) general tuition fees, one hundred fifty dollars per quarter; and
 - (b) incidental fees, not more than twenty dollars per quarter.

WAC 131-28-020 EFFECTIVE DATE OF SUMMER QUARTER FEE SCHEDULE. WAC 131-28-010 shall govern the assessment of general tuition and incidental fees for the summer quarter of 1971 and all subsequent summer quarters.
