RESOLUTION NO. 70- 15

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 7

A resolution relating to permanent rules of the State Board for Community College Education.

BE IT RESOLVED by a majority of the State Board for Community College Education that the annexed regulations, to-wit:

- A. WAC 131-28-030 concerning waiver of fees for high school completion students;
- B. WAC 131-28-040 concerning eligibility for waiver of fees for such students; and
- C. WAC 131-28-050 concerning limitations on waiver of fees for such students;

are hereby approved and adopted as permanent rules of the State Board for Community College Education.

WAC 131-28-030 WAIVER OF FEES FOR HIGH SCHOOL COMPLETION STUDENTS. (1) Pursuant to authority granted by RCW 28B.15.520, the board of trustees of community college districts are authorized to waive general tuition fees, incidental fees, and any other fees for students enrolled in a course of study or program specifically for the purpose of completing a high school education and obtaining a high school diploma, provided the student shall qualify for such waiver as determined by the criteria set forth in WAC 131-28-030 through WAC 131-28-050.

(2) In determining eligibility for such waiver, the college districts shall first exhaust all free methods for making such determination before requiring any method for which the applicant must pay a processing fee.

WAC 131-28-040 CRITERIA FOR DETERMINATION OF ELIGIBILITY FOR WAIVER OF FEES FOR HIGH SCHOOL COMPLETION STUDENTS. Waiver of general tuition fees, incidental fees, and any other fees, or any portions thereof, normally charged to students enrolled in high school completion courses or programs shall be based upon the determination that the student is a needy student by virtue of either:

(1) His qualification for a College Work-Study award by whatever method the district's institutions establish eligibility for such awards, or

(2) His qualification for an Educational Opportunity Grant by whatever method the district's institutions establish eligibility for such grants, or

(3) His qualification for financial assistance due to a temporary financial loss or inability to earn that, in the judgment of the appropriately designated official of the college district or campus, would prevent his enrolling in such high school completion courses or program unless all or part of the required general tuition fee, incidental fee, and other fees associated with such enrollment were waived.

WAC 131-28-050 LIMITATIONS ON WAIVER OF FEES FOR HIGH SCHOOL COMPLETION STUDENTS. The waiver of fees for any quarter authorized in WAC 131-28-030 shall apply only to that portion of the student's combined general tuition fee, incidental fee, and other fees that exceed one-fourth of the "effective annual income available for education purposes" of the student, or his parents, or other individuals legally responsible for the care and maintenance of the student. For the purposes of this section, the "effective annual income available for education purpose" shall be the amount remaining when the annual income of the student, and/or his parents, or other individuals legally responsible for the care and maintenance of the student is reduced by (1) the projected annual cost of the student's attendance at the community college, and (2) the projected annual costs of maintaining all persons dependent upon such annual income, including the educational costs of any other dependents.
