A resolution relating to the permanent rules of State Board for Community College Education.

BE IT RESOLVED by the State Board for Community College Education.


Section 1. The amended regulation, to-wit:

Single-sum death benefit to spouse beneficiaries. Unless previously indicated to the contrary by the participating employee in writing directly to TIAA/CREF, the surviving spouse of any TIAA/CREF participant who dies before retirement shall be entitled to receive a single-sum death benefit in the amount of the then current value of the annuity accumulation.

IT IS HEREBY APPROVED AND ADOPTED as a permanent rule of the State Board for Community College Education.

Section 2. This resolution and annexed regulation, after being first recorded as an administrative order in the Order Register of the State Board for Community College Education shall be forwarded to the Code Reviser for filing pursuant to RCW 34.04 and WAC 1-12-050

WAC 131-16-066 - SINGLE SUM DEATH BENEFIT TO SPOUSE BENEFICIARIES
Unless previously indicated to the contrary by the participating employee in writing directly to TIAA-CREF, the surviving spouse of any TIAA-CREF plan participant who dies before retirement shall be entitled to receive a single sum death benefit in the amount of the then current value of the annuity accumulation.
