

A resolution related to assessing tuition and fees for certain ungraded courses.

BE IT RESOLVED by the State Board for Community College Education that it adopt a tuition and fee schedule for certain ungraded courses offered by community colleges described in WAC 131-28-026 (annexed hereto and identified as Exhibit I to this resolution) thereby approved and adopted as a permanent rule of the State Board for Community College Education, effective July 1, 1974.

This resolution and the annexed regulations, after being first recorded as an administrative order in the order register of the State Board for Community College Education, shall be forwarded to the Code Reviser for filing pursuant to RCW 34.04 and WAC 1-12-050.

WAC 131-28-026 TUITION AND FEE CHARGES FOR CERTAIN UNGRADED COURSES. For the purpose of implementing WAC 131-28-025(2), the tuition and fees, exclusive of special fees, charged by any Washington community college for the following courses shall be:

<u>Course</u>	<u>Tuition</u>	<u>Fees</u>
(1) Washington Apprenticeship and Training Council approved apprenticeship related training, other than federal apprenticeship programs	\$10.50 per year	\$10.50 per year
(2) WISHA approved Industrial first aid courses	No charge	No charge
(3) Parent education involving cooperative pre-school program	1/2 standard district part-time charge per credit per quarter less 1/2 of pre-school cooperative fee	1/2 standard district part-time charge per credit per quarter less 1/2 of pre-school cooperative fee
(4) Farm management	\$18.75 per two-member family unit per year plus \$9.40 for each additional family member enrolled	\$18.75 per two-member family unit per year plus \$9.40 for each additional family member enrolled

For the purpose of computing any refunds related to such tuition and fees charged for apprenticeship and farm management courses, the total tuition and fees charged on a yearly basis shall be pro-rated to a quarterly basis.
