A resolution relating to the waiver of tuition and fees for students enrolled in community colleges.

BE IT RESOLVED by the State Board for Community College Education that it adopt Administrative Order No. 38 and the amended regulation, annexed hereto and made a part hereof by this reference, amending WAC 131-28-030 providing for authorization for community college districts to waive tuition and fees for certain children of law enforcement officers and fire fighters who died or were disabled in line of duty in the State of Washington.

This regulation and the annexed amended rule after being first recorded as an Administrative Order in the Order Register of the State Board for Community College Education shall be forwarded to the Code Reviser for codification in the Washington Administrative Code.

WAC 131-28-030 WAIVER OF FEES FOR HIGH SCHOOL COMPLETION AND COLLEGIATE PROGRAM STUDENTS. Pursuant to authority granted by Chapter 28B.15 RCW, the board of trustees of community college districts are authorized to waive all or part of general tuition, operating, and services and activities fees for students enrolled in a course of study or program specifically for the purpose of completing a high school education and obtaining a high school diploma or its equivalent or for students enrolled in collegiate-level courses or programs, provided the student shall qualify for such waiver as determined by the criteria set forth in WAC 131-28-040 through WAC 131-28-050. In determining eligibility for such waiver, the college districts shall first exhaust all free methods of making such determination before requiring any method for which the applicant must pay a processing fee. In addition, the boards of trustees of community college districts are hereby authorized pursuant to RCW 28B.15.520 to waive general tuition fees, operating fees, services and activities fees, and any other fees for students over the age of 19 years who are the children of any law enforcement officer or fire fighter who lost his life or became totally disabled in the line of duty while employed by any public law enforcement agency or full time or volunteer fire department in the State of Washington.
