RESOLUTION NO. 77-46

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER NO. 64

(1) Be it resolved by the State Board for Community College Education, State of Washington, that it promulgate and adopt as emergency rules of this governing body, the annexed rules: Establishing tuition and fee charges to be made by community college districts for certain ungraded courses.

We, the State Board for Community College Education, find that an emergency exists and that the foregoing order is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, or general welfare and that observation of the requirements of notice and opportunity to present views on the proposed action would be contrary to public interest. A statement of the facts constituting such emergency is: The 45th Washington Legislature has adopted a schedule of increased tuition and fees for higher education institutions and the State Board wishes to adjust certain other fees for which it has statutory authority to fix so that such increases will correspond to the applicability of the other fee increases. In addition, it is the intent of the State Board to make the increased fees applicable for the 1977-78 academic year and to extend them to one additional category of ungraded courses. In order to have a rule that will be effective in time for registration for the Fall Quarter, 1977, it is necessary to adopt the rule fixing such fees on an emergency basis.

Such rules are therefore adopted as emergency rules to take effect upon filing with the Code Reviser.

(2) This rule is promulgated pursuant to RCW 28B.15.500 and is intended to administratively implement that statute.

(3) This order after being first recorded in the order register of this governing body shall be forwarded to the Code Reviser for filing pursuant to chapter 34.04 RCW and chapter 1-12 WAC.

AMENDATORY SECTION

WAC 131-28-026 TUITION AND FEE CHARGES FOR CERTAIN UNGRADED COURSES. For the purpose of implementing WAC 131-28-025(2), the tuition and fees, exclusive of special fees, charged by any Washington community college for the following ungraded courses shall be:

For the purpose of computing any refunds related to such tuition and fees charged for apprenticeship, small business management and farm management courses, the total tuition and fees charged on a yearly basis shall be prorated to a quarterly basis.
