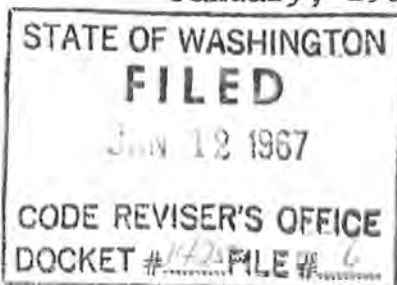

EMERGENCY TEMPORARY REGULATION No. 261

N O T I C E

The following Emergency Rule and Regulation was duly and regularly passed and adopted at a regular meeting, January 9, 1967, of the State Game Commission for the State of Washington.

RESOLVED: That the Emergency Rule and regulation hereinafter set forth was duly ordered, adopted and promulgated by vote of the State Game Commission.

RESOLVED FURTHER: That Temporary Regulation No. 253 shall be amended to close the either sex elk season in the following described area effective at sunset, January 15, 1967:

Elwha River Area (Clallam County) - All lands within one mile of the Elwha River between the National Park boundary and the Olympic Highway

The foregoing Emergency Temporary Regulation No. 261 shall be forthwith entered and recorded in the minutes of the State Game Commission and published at Olympia, Thurston County, Washington, and the Port Angeles News as provided by law, for one issue.
