EMERGENCY TEMPORARY REGULATION NO. 278

N O T I C E

The following resolution and regulation was duly and regularly passed and adopted at a regular meeting, June 25, 1968, of the State Game Commission for the State of Washington.

RESOLVED: That the Emergency Temporary Regulation herein-after set forth was duly ordered, adopted and promulgated by vote of the State Game Commission.

RESOLVED FURTHER: That Temporary Regulation No. 273 shall be amended to read as follows:

It shall be lawful to fish for game fish in Spectacle Lake, Okanogan County, State of Washington, April 21, 1968 to and including September 30, 1968.

Provided that the regular summer catch and possession limits and the six-inch size limit shall be effective during the aforesaid season.

The foregoing Emergency Temporary Regulation No. 278 shall be forthwith entered and recorded in the minutes of the Commission and published in Olympia, Thurston County, Washington, as provided by law, and in the Okanogan Independent for one issue.
