The following resolution and regulation was duly and regularly passed and adopted at a regular meeting, June 25, 1968, of the State Game Commission for the State of Washington.

RESOLVED: That the Temporary Rule and Regulation hereinafter set forth was duly ordered, adopted and promulgated by vote of the State Game Commission to be effective as of September 1, 1968.

RESOLVED: That it shall be lawful to hunt band-tailed pigeons and mourning doves in the State of Washington during the following open seasons, with bag limits as prescribed for each species.

GENERAL OPEN SEASONS:

Band-tailed pigeons: September 1 to 30, 1968, both dates inclusive,

Mourning doves: September 1 to 30, 1968, both dates inclusive.

BAG LIMITS:

Band-tailed pigeons:

Daily Bag Limit: Eight (8)

Possession Limit: Eight (8)

Mourning doves:

Daily Bag Limit: Ten (10)

Possession Limit: Twenty (20)

HUNTING HOURS: Lawful hunting hours for band-tailed pigeons and mourning doves shall be as follows:
