

N O T I C E

The following resolution and regulation was duly and regularly passed and adopted at a regular meeting, October 7, 1968, of the State Game Commission for the State of Washington.

RESOLVED: That the Emergency Rule and Regulation hereinafter set forth was duly ordered, adopted and promulgated by vote of the State Game Commission.

RESOLVED FURTHER: That this Commission finds that the immediate adoption of this amendment of the boundaries of the Stratford Game Reserve is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare, and that observance of the requirements of notice and opportunity to present views on the proposed action would be contrary to the public interest for the reasons that the Commission has caused to be introduced into the area near the Stratford Game Reserve, as amended, antelope, and some of the antelope have migrated into the boundaries of the Stratford Game Reserve, as amended. These antelope are not yet in such numbers that they may be hunted, and they require, at this time, in order to survive and reproduce, an area completely free of hunting pressure.

RESOLVED FURTHER: That the STRATFORD GAME RESERVE, Grant County, State of Washington, as established by Temporary Regulation No. 156 and WAC 232-16-400, shall be amended to include the following lands:

In Township 22 North, Range 28 East W.M.; Section 1 North of the Great Northern Railroad right-of-way; Section 2 North of the Great Northern Railroad right-of-way and primary state highway No. 7; Sections 3 and 4 North of the main canal; Section 5 North of the Coulee City-Stratford County Road;

In Township 23 North, Range 28 East W.M.; Those parts of Sections 8, 28 and 32 that are East of the Coulee City-Stratford County Road; all of Sections 11, 13, 14, 15, 16, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 33, 34 and 35; the South half (S $\frac{1}{2}$) of Sections 12, 10 and 9, EXCEPT the North 300 feet of the South half (S $\frac{1}{2}$) of 9 and 10; Section 36, EXCEPT the East 500 feet; AND EXCEPT a strip of land 400 feet wide in the Southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$) and the South half of the Northeast quarter (S $\frac{1}{2}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 34, Township 23 North, Range 28 East W.M., and in that part of the Northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section 3, Township 22 North, Range 28 East W.M. lying North of the main irrigation canal, said 400-foot strip being so situated that its East boundary is parallel to and 500 feet West of the East line of said Sections 34 and 3.

The foregoing Emergency Rule and Regulation No. 285 shall be forthwith entered and recorded in the minutes of the Commission and published in Olympia, Thurston County, Washington, as provided by law, for one issue.
