BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GAME COMMISSION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF GAME, STATE OF WASHINGTON:

Section 1. The annexed regulations, to-wit:

WAC 232-16-070 Colockum Game Reserve

WAC 232-16-400 Stratford Game Reserve

Special Hunting Seasons (raccoon, bobcat,  
rock chuck)

are hereby approved and adopted as rules and regulations of the Department of Game.

SPECIAL HUNTING SEASONS

RACCOON:

Open Seasons: Year-round in Clallam, Jefferson, Grays Harbor, Mason, Pacific, Kitsap, Island and San Juan Counties.

August 1 to March 31 yearly until changed in remainder of Washington.

Bag Limit: No limit.

BOBCAT:

Open Seasons: Year-round in the entire state.

Bag Limit: No limit.

ROCK CHUCK: (Yellow-bellied marmot)

Open Seasons: Year-round in Chelan, Okanogan and Douglas Counties

April 1 to September 1 yearly until changed in remainder of Eastern Washington.

Bag Limit: No limit.

WAC 232-16-070 COLOCKUM GAME RESERVE shall include those lands within the following described boundary: Beginning at the point where the Brewton road crosses the south line of Section 19, Twp. 20 N., R. 21 E.W.M.; thence northwesterly along the Brewton road to the Colockum Pass road in Section 13, Twp. 20 N., R. 20 E.; thence northerly on the Colockum Pass road to its junction with the Naneum Lookout road in Section 13, Twp. 20 N., R. 20 E.; thence westerly along the Naneum Lookout road to where it crosses the Bonneville Power Line right-of-way in Section 16, Twp. 20 N., R. 20 E.; thence southwesterly along the power line to the Colockum Wildlife Recreation Area boundary on the south line of Section 20, Twp. 20 N., R. 20 E.; thence easterly along the south line of Sections 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, Twp. 20 N., R. 20 E., and Section 19, Twp. 20 N., R. 21 E.W.M. to the Brewton road and the point of beginning.

WAC 232-16-400 STRATFORD GAME RESERVE shall include the following described lands in Grant County: In Twp. 22 N., R. 28 E.W.M.; Sec. 1 north of the Great Northern Railroad right-of-way; Sec. 2 north of the Great Northern Railroad right-of-way and state highway No. 28; Section 3 and 4 north of the main canal; Sec. 5 north of the Coulee City-Stratford County road;

In Twp. 23 N., R. 28 E.W.M.; those parts of Sections 8, 28 and 32 that are east of the Coulee City-Stratford County road; all of Sections 11, 13, 14, 15, 16, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 33, 34 and 35; the south half of Sections 12, 10 and 9 EXCEPT the north 300 feet of the S.  $\frac{1}{2}$  of 9 and 10; Sec. 36 EXCEPT the east 500 feet; AND EXCEPT a strip of land 400 feet wide in S.E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  and S.  $\frac{1}{2}$  of the N.E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 34, Twp. 23 N., R. 28 E.W.M., and in that part of the N.E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 3, Twp. 22 N., R. 28 E.W.M. lying north of the main irrigation canal, said 400-foot strip being so situated that its east boundary is parallel to and 500 feet west of the east line of said sections 34 and 3; and in addition the north 500 feet of the N.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of S.W.  $\frac{1}{4}$  of Sec. 19, Twp. 23 N., R. 29 E.W.M.
