REGULATION OF THE COUNTY ROAD ADMINISTRATION BOARD  
ESTABLISHING A STANDARD OF GOOD PRACTICE REGARDING  
PUBLICATION OF INFORMATION ON DAY LABOR PROJECTS.

WHEREAS, Chapter 120, Laws of 1965, First Extraordinary Session, created the County Road Administration Board to formulate and adopt uniform and general practices relating to the administration of county roads for the several counties of the state, and

WHEREAS, the Board deems it to be a standard of good practice to permit alternate means of complying with statutory publication requirements for day labor projects. Now, therefore,

BE IT ESTABLISHED BY THE COUNTY ROAD ADMINISTRATION BOARD:

Section 1. The standard of good practice regarding publication of information on day labor projects which is designated WAC 136-16-060, attached hereto, be and the same is hereby adopted and established for the county road departments in the several counties of the State of Washington.

Section 2. The standard as adopted hereby shall become effective immediately and shall be adhered to by all counties in the state.

Established and adopted by the Board this 9 day of July 1971, at a hearing held pursuant to notice given as required by law.

Chapter 16

STANDARD OF GOOD PRACTICE  
REGARDING PUBLICATION OF INFORMATION  
ON DAY LABOR PROJECTS

NEW WAC 136-16-060 PUBLICATION OF INFORMATION ON DAY LABOR  
PROJECTS.

Each Board of County Commissioners is required by law to publish a brief description of each day labor project exceeding a cost of twenty five hundred dollars with an accurate statement of the true and complete cost of performing such construction upon completion of the project.

Such information may be published upon completion of individual projects, or by making a consolidated publication covering all day labor projects over twenty five hundred dollars no later than March 1 of the year succeeding the program year.
