## WSR 21-15-073 EMERGENCY RULES DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND WILDLIFE

[Order 21-121—Filed July 16, 2021, 12:11 p.m., effective July 19, 2021]

Effective Date of Rule: July 19, 2021.

Purpose: The purpose of this emergency rule is to close Chinook retention in Marine Area 5.

Citation of Rules Affected by this Order: Amending WAC 220-313-060.

Statutory Authority for Adoption: RCW 77.04.012, 77.04.020, 77.12.045, and 77.12.047.

Under RCW 34.05.350 the agency for good cause finds that immediate adoption, amendment, or repeal of a rule is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety, or general welfare, and that observing the time requirements of notice and opportunity to comment upon adoption of a permanent rule would be contrary to the public interest.

Reasons for this Finding: The current estimate of total legalsized Chinook encounters through July 15 is 5,894 (seventy-eight percent) of the total 7,565 legal-sized encounters agreed up in this year's list of agreed fisheries. Because of the high number of encounters this early in the season, Chinook retention will be suspended. Encounter estimates will be updated again after Chinook retention ends, and staff will reevaluate and determine the best course of action for the remainder of the season. There is insufficient time to adopt permanent rules.

WAC 220-313-06000F Puget Sound salmon—Saltwater seasons and daily limits. (a) Daily limit 2.
