8 in grades kindergarten through three; (ii) fifty-two certificated
9 instructional and administrative staff to one thousand annual
10 average full time equivalent students enrolled in grades four
11 through twelve; and (iii) eighteen classified personnel to one
12 thousand annual average full time equivalent students enrolled in
13 grades kindergarten through twelve.

14 (d) The formula adopted by the legislature for the 1993-94
15 school year shall reflect the following ratios at a minimum: (i)
16 Fifty-nine certificated instructional and administrative staff to
17 one thousand annual average full time equivalent students enrolled
18 in grades kindergarten through three; (ii) fifty-three certificated
19 instructional and administrative staff to one thousand annual
20 average full time equivalent students enrolled in grades four
21 through twelve; and (iii) nineteen classified personnel to one
22 thousand annual average full time equivalent students enrolled in
23 grades kindergarten through twelve.

24 (e) The formula adopted by the legislature for the 1994-95
25 school year shall reflect the following ratios at a minimum: (i)
26 Sixty certificated instructional and administrative staff to one

1 thousand annual average full time equivalent students enrolled in
2 grades kindergarten through three; (ii) fifty-four certificated
3 instructional and administrative staff to one thousand annual
4 average full time equivalent students enrolled in grades four
5 through twelve; and (iii) twenty classified personnel to one
6 thousand annual average full time equivalent students enrolled in
7 grades kindergarten through twelve.

8 (f) Commencing with the 1995-96 school year, the formula
9 adopted by the legislature shall reflect the following ratios at a
10 minimum: (i) Sixty-one certificated instructional and
11 administrative staff to one thousand annual average full time
12 equivalent students enrolled in grades kindergarten through three;
13 (ii) fifty-five certificated instructional and administrative staff
14 to one thousand annual average full time equivalent students
15 enrolled in grades four through twelve; and (iii) twenty classified
16 personnel to one thousand annual average full time equivalent
17 students enrolled in grades kindergarten through twelve."
