EFFECT: Provides a 10% salary increase on July 1 to  
Transportation Engineers and Technicians. Other engineering  
classes retain a 5% increase on Jan. 1, 1992. Previously,  
transportation engineers & technicians were included in the 5%  
increase. Net additional appropriations: \$65,000 GFS, \$2,000  
GFF, and \$2,281,000 from the special fund salary and insurance  
contribution increase revolving fund.
