4 On page 136, after line 21, insert the following:

5 "(4) The Washington state institute of public policy shall
6 prepare a report on "different and innovative rehab" programs
7 that provide education, rehabilitation activities, treatment, and
8 aftercare for first time offenders and drug offenders. The
9 report shall include but not be limited to the following:

10 (a) A description of the components of each of these
11 programs and how they operate.

12 (b) The rehabilitative components of each of the programs,
13 and data describing rehabilitation outcomes in each of the
14 programs.

15 (c) Comparative recidivism data for each program discussed
16 that includes comparison with appropriate programs in the United
17 States, and with other programs discussed in the report.

18 (d) The types of offenders best suited to each program.

19 (e) The direct and nondirect cost associated with housing,
20 training staff, planning, and operating each of the programs.

21 The institute shall submit the report to the governor, the
22 legislature, appropriate state agencies, and local corrections
23 agencies by December 12, 1991. Copies of the report shall be
24 made available to the public."
