3 On page 2, after line 3, strike everything through  
4 "commission." on line 7, and insert "(2) The provisions of this  
5 chapter shall not apply to the provision by a common carrier of:

6 (a) Enhanced 911 emergency service approved by the Washington  
7 utilities and transportation commission; or

8 (b) Automatic number, caller or location identification  
9 service, other than enhanced 911 emergency service, approved by the  
10 Washington utilities and transportation commission, if the  
11 telecommunications company which offers the automatic number,  
12 caller, or location identification services, other than enhanced  
13 911, requires a non-residential customer to execute a non-  
14 disclosure agreement which prohibits the non-residential customer  
15 from using any information or numbers obtained from the  
16 telecommunications company for marketing purposes or for matching  
17 with other information without the written consent of the telephone  
18 subscriber whose name, number, and other information is disclosed  
19 to the non-residential customer."

EFFECT: To be exempt from the privacy act, a telecommunication company offering automatic number identification services, must enter into non-disclosure agreements with non-residential customers prohibiting the use of the name and number information for marketing purposes or matching against other information.
