4 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. There is added to chapter 80.36 a new
5 section to read as follows:

6 If the commission authorizes a telecommunications company to
7 provide services that automatically display the caller's name,
8 telephone number, or other identifying information, the commission
9 shall prohibit the telecommunications company from providing any
10 equipment, device, or service capable of storing the name, number,
11 or identifying information. A telecommunications company shall not
12 offer automatic caller, number, or location identification
13 services, other than enhanced 911, to any person unless the person
14 executes an agreement which prohibits the person from storing in
15 any form or manner any information or any numbers obtained from the
16 telecommunications company."

19 On page 1, line 1 of the title, strike "and amending RCW
20 9.73.070" and insert "amending RCW 9.73.070; and adding a new
21 section to chapter 80.36 RCW"

EFFECT: Telecommunications companies providing Caller ID
services may not provide any device or service capable of

storing the number of a person making a call. A person subscribing to Caller ID must sign an agreement that the information will not be stored in any form.
