- 7 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 15. Two hundred thousand dollars of the
- 8 revenue generated from license fees under this chapter shall be placed
- 9 each biennium into the dedicated regional game fish enhancement group
- 10 account created in section 18 of this act, for the purpose of funding
- 11 the activities of the regional game fish enhancement groups under
- 12 section 16 of this act."
- "NEW SECTION. Sec. 16. The legislature authorizes the formation
- 14 of regional game fish enhancement groups. These groups shall be
- 15 eligible for state financial support, shall be actively supported by
- 16 the department, and shall operate strictly on a nonprofit basis. The
- 17 regions in which each group operates shall be determined by the
- 18 director in consultation with the regional game fish enhancement group
- 19 advisory board.
- The regional game fish enhancement groups shall seek to enhance the
- 21 game fish resources of the state by maximizing volunteer efforts and
- 22 shall seek to supplement the fishery enhancement capability of the
- 23 department. The regional game fish enhancement groups shall seek to
- 24 assist the department in achieving the goal of doubling game fish
- 25 production by the year 2000 under RCW 77.12.710. Each regional game
- 26 fish enhancement group shall be incorporated under Title 24 RCW. Any
- 27 interested person or group shall be permitted to join. It is desirable
- 28 for the group to have representation from all classes of fishers,

- 1 persons who have an interest in game fishing within the region, and the
- 2 general public."
- 3 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 17. The regional game fish enhancement group
- 4 advisory board is established to review project proposals from the
- 5 regional game fish enhancement groups and to make recommendations to
- 6 the director regarding proposal funding. The advisory board shall
- 7 consist of seven members appointed by the director. Membership on the
- 8 board shall include sport fishers representing a cross section of game
- 9 fishers in the state. The director, in consultation with the regional
- 10 game fish enhancement group advisory board, shall develop objective
- 11 criteria for funding of proposals."
- 12 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 18. The dedicated regional game fish
- 13 enhancement group account is created in the custody of the state
- 14 treasurer. Only the director or the director's designee may authorize
- 15 expenditures from the account. The account is subject to allotment
- 16 procedures under chapter 43.88 RCW, but no appropriation is required
- 17 for expenditures. The account shall be used exclusively for regional
- 18 game fish enhancement group projects. The department may use the
- 19 account's funds for administrative costs and to provide agency
- 20 assistance to the regional game fish enhancement groups. The amount of
- 21 account funds used by the department shall be determined by the
- 22 director after the regional game fish enhancement groups advisory board
- 23 has reviewed and made recommendations for expenditures. The department
- 24 shall not pay more than twenty percent of annual contributions to the
- 25 account in administrative costs."
- 26 "NEW SECTION. Sec. 19. The department and the regional game
- 27 fish enhancement group advisory board shall report by June 30 of each

- 1 odd-numbered year to the senate environment and natural resources
- 2 committee, the house of representatives fisheries and wildlife
- 3 committee, the senate ways and means committee, and the house of
- 4 representatives fiscal committees, or any successor committees. The
- 5 report shall include, but shall not be limited to, the following:
- 6 (1) An evaluation of enhancement efforts;
- 7 (2) A description of projects;
- 8 (3) A region-by-region accounting of all financial contributions
- 9 and expenditures including the regional game fish enhancement group
- 10 account funds; and
- 11 (4) Volunteer participation and member affiliation."
- 12 "Sec. 20. RCW 77.12.170 and 1989 c 314 s 4 are each amended to

- 14 (1) There is established in the state treasury the state wildlife
- 15 fund which consists of moneys received from:
- 16 (a) Rentals or concessions of the department;
- 17 (b) The sale of real or personal property held for department
- 18 purposes;
- 19 (c) Except as provided in section 15 of this 1991 act, the sale of
- 20 licenses, permits, tags, stamps, and punchcards required by this title;

- 3 (2) State and county officers receiving any moneys listed in

- 5 to be credited to the state wildlife fund."
