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5 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the
6 following:

7 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 43.79 RCW
8 to read as follows:

9 The education support account is created in the state treasury.
10 Money in the account that is attributable to lottery revenue shall be
11 allocated to K-12 education, without supplanting existing basic
12 education support."

13 "**Sec. 2.** RCW 28B.15.031 and 1987 c 15 s 2 are each amended to read
14 as follows:

15 The term "operating fees" as used in this chapter shall include the
16 fees, other than building fees, charged all students registering at the
17 state's colleges and universities but shall not include fees for short
18 courses, self-supporting degree credit programs and courses, marine
19 station work, experimental station work, correspondence or extension
20 courses, and individual instruction and student deposits or rentals,
21 disciplinary and library fines, which colleges and universities shall
22 have the right to impose, laboratory, gymnasium, health, and student
23 activity fees, or fees, charges, rentals, and other income derived from
24 any or all revenue producing lands, buildings and facilities of the
25 colleges or universities heretofore or hereafter acquired, constructed
26 or installed, including but not limited to income from rooms,
27 dormitories, dining rooms, hospitals, infirmaries, housing or student

1 activity buildings, vehicular parking facilities, land, or the
2 appurtenances thereon, or such other special fees as may be established
3 by any college or university board of trustees or regents from time to
4 time. All moneys received as operating fees at any institution of
5 higher education shall be transmitted to the state treasurer within
6 thirty-five days of receipt to be deposited in the ((~~state general~~
7 ~~fund~~)) education support account under section 1 of this act:
8 PROVIDED, That two and one-half percent of moneys received as operating
9 fees be exempt from such deposit and be retained by the institutions
10 for the purposes of RCW 28B.15.820: PROVIDED FURTHER, That money
11 received by institutions of higher education from the periodic payment
12 plan authorized by RCW 28B.15.411 shall be transmitted to the state
13 treasurer within five days following the close of registration of the
14 appropriate quarter or semester."

15 "Sec. 3. RCW 67.70.040 and 1991 c 359 s 1 are each amended to read
16 as follows:

17 The commission shall have the power, and it shall be its duty:

18 (1) To promulgate such rules governing the establishment and
19 operation of a state lottery as it deems necessary and desirable in
20 order that such a lottery be initiated at the earliest feasible and
21 practicable time, and in order that such lottery produce the maximum
22 amount of net revenues for the state consonant with the dignity of the
23 state and the general welfare of the people. Such rules shall include,
24 but shall not be limited to, the following:

25 (a) The type of lottery to be conducted which may include the
26 selling of tickets or shares. The use of electronic or mechanical
27 devices or video terminals which allow for individual play against such
28 devices or terminals shall be prohibited. Approval of the legislature

1 shall be required before entering any agreement with other state
2 lotteries to conduct shared games;

3 (b) The price, or prices, of tickets or shares in the lottery;

4 (c) The numbers and sizes of the prizes on the winning tickets or
5 shares;

6 (d) The manner of selecting the winning tickets or shares;

7 (e) The manner and time of payment of prizes to the holder of
8 winning tickets or shares which, at the director's option, may be paid
9 in lump sum amounts or installments over a period of years;

10 (f) The frequency of the drawings or selections of winning tickets
11 or shares, without limitation;

12 (g) Without limit as to number, the type or types of locations at
13 which tickets or shares may be sold;

14 (h) The method to be used in selling tickets or shares;

15 (i) The licensing of agents to sell or distribute tickets or
16 shares, except that a person under the age of eighteen shall not be
17 licensed as an agent;

18 (j) The manner and amount of compensation, if any, to be paid
19 licensed sales agents necessary to provide for the adequate
20 availability of tickets or shares to prospective buyers and for the
21 convenience of the public;

22 (k) The apportionment of the total revenues accruing from the sale
23 of lottery tickets or shares and from all other sources among: (i) The
24 payment of prizes to the holders of winning tickets or shares, which
25 shall not be less than forty-five percent of the gross annual revenue
26 from such lottery, less amounts of unclaimed prizes deposited in the
27 general fund under RCW 67.70.190 during the fiscal year ending June 30,
28 1989, (ii) transfers to the lottery administrative account created by
29 RCW 67.70.260, and (iii) transfer to the ~~((state's general fund))~~
30 education support account under section 1 of this act. Transfers to

1 the (~~state general fund~~) education support account shall be made in
2 compliance with RCW 43.01.050;

3 (1) Such other matters necessary or desirable for the efficient and
4 economical operation and administration of the lottery and for the
5 convenience of the purchasers of tickets or shares and the holders of
6 winning tickets or shares.

7 (2) To ensure that in each place authorized to sell lottery tickets
8 or shares, on the back of the ticket or share, and in any advertising
9 or promotion there shall be conspicuously displayed an estimate of the
10 probability of purchasing a winning ticket.

11 (3) To amend, repeal, or supplement any such rules from time to
12 time as it deems necessary or desirable.

13 (4) To advise and make recommendations to the director for the
14 operation and administration of the lottery."

15 "**Sec. 4.** RCW 67.70.240 and 1987 c 513 s 7 are each amended to read
16 as follows:

17 The moneys in the state lottery account shall be used only: (1)
18 For the payment of prizes to the holders of winning lottery tickets or
19 shares; (2) for purposes of making deposits into the reserve account
20 created by RCW 67.70.250 and into the lottery administrative account
21 created by RCW 67.70.260; (3) for purposes of making deposits into the
22 (~~state's general fund~~) education support account under section 1 of
23 this act; (4) (~~for purposes of making deposits into the housing trust~~
24 ~~fund under the provisions of section 7 of this 1987 act; (5)) for the
25 purchase and promotion of lottery games and game-related services; and
26 (~~(+6))~~ (5) for the payment of agent compensation.~~

27 The office of financial management shall require the allotment of
28 all expenses paid from the account and shall report to the ways and

1 means committees of the senate and house of representatives any changes
2 in the allotments."

3 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 5.** This act shall take effect July 1,
4 1993."
