3 On page 95, after line 4, strike all of section 314 and
4 insert:

14 The appropriations in this section are subject to the
15 following conditions and limitations:

16 (1) Within the appropriations provided in this section, the
17 department shall collect and provide information to growers on
18 minor use crop pesticides.

19 (2) \$100,000 of the general fund--state appropriation is
20 provided solely to implement the Puget Sound water quality
21 management plan.

22 (3) ((~~\$872,000~~)) \$799,000 of the general fund--state
23 appropriation is provided solely for the state noxious weed

1 program. Of this amount ((~~\$524,000~~)) \$451,000 is provided solely
2 for noxious weed control grants.

3 (4) The appropriations in this section are based on an
4 assumption that the IMPACT program will establish fees pursuant to
5 RCW 28B.30.541.

6 (5) \$97,000 of the general fund--state appropriation is
7 provided solely to implement chapter 280, Laws of 1991 (Engrossed
8 Second Substitute Senate Bill No. 5096, adverse impacts on
9 agriculture).

10 (6) \$30,000 of the general fund--state appropriation is
11 provided solely for the Taiwan office."

EFFECT: Replaces section on appropriations for the Department
of Agriculture. Increases General Fund-State appropriation by
\$2,318,000 and eliminates dedicated fund appropriations.
Eliminates proviso on use of dedicated funds. (Increases
original 1991-93 General Fund-State appropriation by
\$453,000.)
