3 On page 36, beginning on line 12, strike all of Sec. 210

4 Renumber the remaining sections consecutively and correct
5 internal references accordingly.

6 On page 43, beginning on line 11, strike all material through
7 page 55, line 17

8 Renumber the remaining section consecutively and correct
9 internal references accordingly.

10 EFFECT: Removes council authority to impose sanctions on funding
11 sources through a "finding of inconsistency" with regional
12 transportation plans and strategies and state policies. Funding
13 sources affected by removal of this sanction are federal aviation
14 funds, regional transportation planning funds, public transit
15 accounts, urban arterial funds, high capacity transportation
16 account, ferry system terminal improvements, local option vehicle
17 license fee, commercial parking tax, street utility charge, port
18 district levies and local transit sales taxes.

19 Reference deleted but funds subject to sanction under existing
20 law are federal highway and transit funds, transportation
21 improvement account monies and high capacity transit taxes. In
22 addition, urban arterial trust account funds can be sanctioned for
23 failure to comply with GMA.
