**HB 2830 - H AMD 0154 ADOPTED 2/15/92**

2 By Representatives Hine, Haugen, Locke, Mitchell and Horn

3 On page 2, line 21, strike "and the county" and insert  
4 "county, and unincorporated areas. The number of central city  
5 members, other component city members, and unincorporated area  
6 members on each committee shall be in proportion to the populations  
7 of the central city, other component cities, and unincorporated  
8 area of the county. Central city members shall be elected city  
9 officials of the central city selected by the central city. Other  
10 component city members shall be elected city officials of the other  
11 component cities selected by the other component cities using a  
12 procedure established by the county. Unincorporated area members  
13 shall be selected using a procedure established by the county that  
14 includes a division of the unincorporated area into separate  
15 geographic areas with the community councils and neighborhood  
16 associations within each geographic area selecting a representative  
17 from that unincorporated area. Committee members shall be subject  
18 to chapter 42.17 RCW"

EFFECT: Requires unincorporated area members to be on intergovernmental committees. Requires proportional representation of central city, other component city, and unincorporated area members on intergovernmental committees. Provides general direction as to how unincorporated area members are selected.
